Tone 6 is the low level tone. The pitch remains at the low pitch throughout the whole syllable. The pitch of Tone 6 is slightly lower than the pitch of Tone 3.

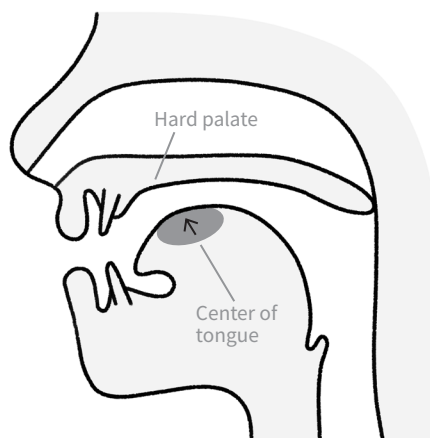

Raise the center of your tongue toward your hard palate quickly. You will feel the left and right sides of your tongue touch your upper teeth.

TIPS!

The initial j is not pronounced like the English *j* sound (as in the word *job*). Don't be confused by the letter *j*.

In the last lesson, we have learned the finals with -m, -n and -ng. In this lesson, we will focus on the finals with the ending consonants -p, -t and -k.

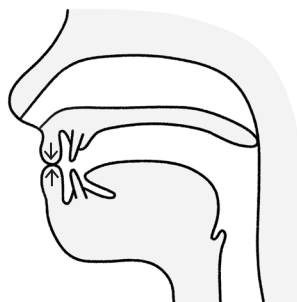

TIPS!

If a syllable has a final ending with -p, -t or -k, the tone of that syllable will generally be a level tone (Tone 1, Tone 3 or Tone 6). There are only very few exceptions.

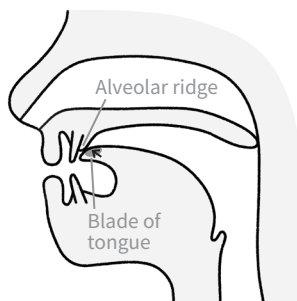

Blade of tongue
The flat part just behind your tongue tip

Alveolar ridge
The small ridge just behind your upper front teeth



After saying the vowel, raise the blade of your tongue to your alveolar ridge until they are in contact. Don't lower the blade of your tongue immediately. Keep the blade of your tongue at the same position until the next syllable. You will feel like the syllable being cut suddenly.

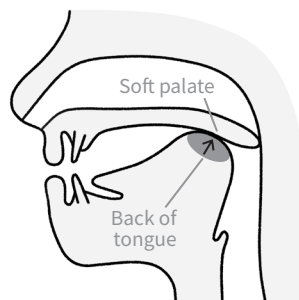

After saying the vowel, raise the back of your tongue to your soft palate. You will feel your whole tongue move backward. Don't lower the back of your tongue immediately. Keep the back of your tongue at the same position until the next syllable. You will feel like the syllable being cut suddenly.

TIPS! When saying the vowel i in ik or the vowel u in uk, open your mouth a little more than when you say the vowel i or the vowel u individually.
